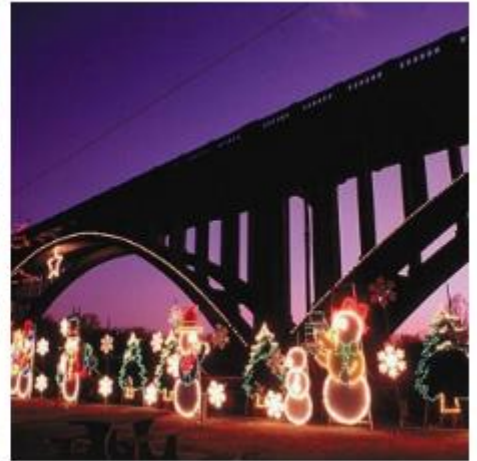


BRANSON, MO – CHRISTMAS EXTRAVAGANZA!

Day to Day Itinerary:

Day 1: Black Hills to Dakota Dunes, SD (430 miles)

Today our journey begins as we leave the Black Hills and travel to Dakota Dunes, SD. We will make regular stops with lunch being at Al's Oasis. Our expected arrival time in Dakota Dunes is late afternoon and there will be time to freshen up at our hotel before supper.

Day 4: Branson

Day 5: Branson

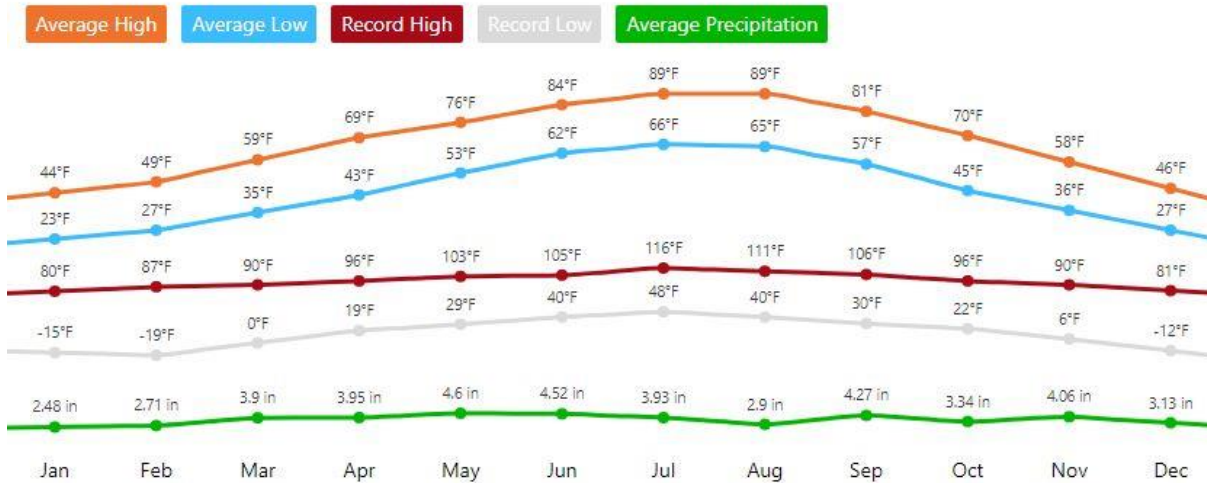
