
Rapid City, Billings, Cody, Yellowstone NP & Tetons, NP & Jackson Hole





Transportation will be in our 12 passenger Mercedes Sprinter vehicle so we can stop and start whenever you wish. When we are touring the vehicle will be used for shuttling wherever you may need to go.

This is a basic outline of the itinerary and it can be adjusted wherever necessary.

Day to Day Itinerary:

Day 1 – Monday 9th September - Arrive Rapid City, SD and transfer to Hotel. Overnight Rapid City, SD

Day 2 – Tuesday 10th September - Black Hills Touring & Entrance fees included Tour from Rapid City to Mt Rushmore, Crazy Horse and Custer State Park. Overnight Rapid City, SD

Day 3 – Wednesday 11th September - Rapid City to Little Big Horn, MT – 300 miles then to Billings (60 miles)

Overnight Billings, MT – No meals included – Touring and entrance fees included

Day 4 – Thursday 12th September - Billings, MT to Cody, WY – (150 miles) If we leave at 8am this should put us into Cody around lunchtime Afternoon exploring the Buffalo Bill Museum and enjoy a Cowboy Supper & Show. Overnight Cody – Supper & Show included.

Day 5 – Friday 13th September - Cody to Yellowstone – (90 Miles)

Todays journey is not very long mileage wise but as we enter Yellowstone National Park the driving becomes slow due to mountainous terrain and park speed limits...

On March 1, 1872, Yellowstone became the first national park for all to enjoy the unique hydrothermal and geologic features. Within Yellowstone's 2.2 million acres, visitors have unparalleled opportunities to observe wildlife in an intact ecosystem, explore geothermal areas that contain about half the world's active geysers, and view geologic wonders like the Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone River. The journey time to Old Faithful is around 3 ½ to 4 hours. Continue to our accommodations in Yellowstone NP.

Overnight Yellowstone NP – No meals included – Touring and Entrance fees included

Day 6 – Saturday 14th September - Touring Yellowstone NP

A full day exploring Yellowstone NP

Return to our accommodations in Yellowstone.

Overnight Yellowstone National Park – no meals included – Entrance fees included

Day 7 – Sunday 15th September - Yellowstone, WY to Jackson Hole, WY– (100 miles)

Our journey today takes us south towards the Grand Teton Mountains and what a magnificent sight they are. A slow driving day today as we meander through Yellowstone NP and into Grand Teton NP.

Jackson Hole is a vacation destination like no other. In fact, that's what Jackson Hole is famous for—it has skiing, fishing, rafting, ranches, fine dining, and more. There's something for everyone here and that's what makes it such a well-loved vacation spot.

Day 8 – Monday 16th September - Exploring Jackson Hole and surrounding area
